Before applying window film it is important to ensure that the application of the film is suitable for your particular type of glass. This window film compatibility chart provides you details of what window film is suitable for what glass.

In all cases, your glazing should meet the Code of Practice, BS.6262 Pts. 1-7 and BS. 8000 Glazing Workmanship on site. Where any damaged edges are found on the glass, outside of allowable standards, installation should not take place. If there are existing faults in the glazing system, it is possible that the application of film could highlight these faults. In a small number of cases this will generally manifest itself in a visible crack which will emanate from the edge damaged area. However neither the manufacturer nor Twilight Tint Ltd can take responsibility for this type of breakage as it is likely that this may happen even without the film installation. Twilight Tint Ltd cannot be held responsible for problems that arise from applying an incompatible window film or from applying window film to glass with existing defect.
